

Do you know property owners in **Gillespie, Kimble and Kerr counties?** If so, they have probably heard rumblings (and grumblings) about LCRA's newest project, a 138-kV electric transmission line connecting the new Mountain Home Substation to existing substations located in Harper and either Ingram or Hunt.
